Frequently Asked Questions

1) What type of styles do you teach? And in any language?

I teach all styles across many genres including Pop, Rock, Jazz, R&B, Soul, Blues, Musical Theatre and Christian Worship. Apart from English songs, I also coach songs in Mandarin, Cantonese, Hokkien, Japanese, Korean, French, Italian, Spanish, Malay, Hindi and more.

Give me any song you want to learn and I will teach you how to sing it.

2) I have no singing experience at all. Can I still learn?

Absolutely. You are not expected to know how to sing when you walk into your first lesson — that's what I'm here for: to coach, encourage and guide you onto the right track.

No prior training is required. I am experienced in teaching students of all levels and abilities. My individualised teaching approach helps students build a strong vocal foundation and experience steady progress with consistent home practice.

3) How long does it take to learn singing?

The pace of vocal progress depends on your ability, musical background, self-initiative, and especially your home practice habits.

Once you begin vocal study, I recommend committing to at least 3 months of regular lessons to experience discernible progress. Professional singers often train for years, especially if aiming for advanced-level singing.

However, if you are learning for leisure or simply want to improve your singing confidently, even 1–6 months of lessons can already help you make noticeable improvements.

4) How many lessons should I sign up for?

I recommend beginning with the Signature Trial Class so that you can experience the studio without making a major commitment.

If you enjoy the experience and would like to continue, you may then register for a package. A minimum commitment of 3 months is recommended for steady vocal development.

5) What can I expect in the Signature Trial Class?

This 60-minute session gives students the opportunity to determine whether the studio is a good fit for them.

We will discuss your experience, goals and interests. I will also assess your current technique and vocal range through warmups and exercises. You will be asked to sing a familiar song of your choice, after which I will suggest strategies and training goals to help you improve.

6) How often must I come for lessons?

Once a week is most ideal, though fortnightly lessons can also work well alongside consistent home practice.

If you require more intensive training, you may opt for twice-weekly sessions or longer lesson durations.

7) Does age matter?

Anyone can learn singing regardless of age — you simply need to be able to concentrate and follow instructions.

For children, the recommended minimum age is 4 years old. My youngest student so far has been age 5 and my oldest age 74.

8) How can I book for a class?

Booking is easy — simply contact me via WhatsApp at 87977800 and let me know your preferred dates and time slots. I'll get back to you with available timings.

9) When are you available?

I teach almost daily from Mondays to Sundays, between 10.30am and 9.30pm.

The first lesson slot starts at 10.30am and the final slot begins at 8.30pm. The studio is closed on Public Holidays.

10) What payment modes do you accept?

The preferred payment mode is via PayNow to 87977800 (Narelle Ong). I also accept Cash and Cheque.

For Credit Card payments, transactions are processed via PayPal and a 5% transaction fee applies.
